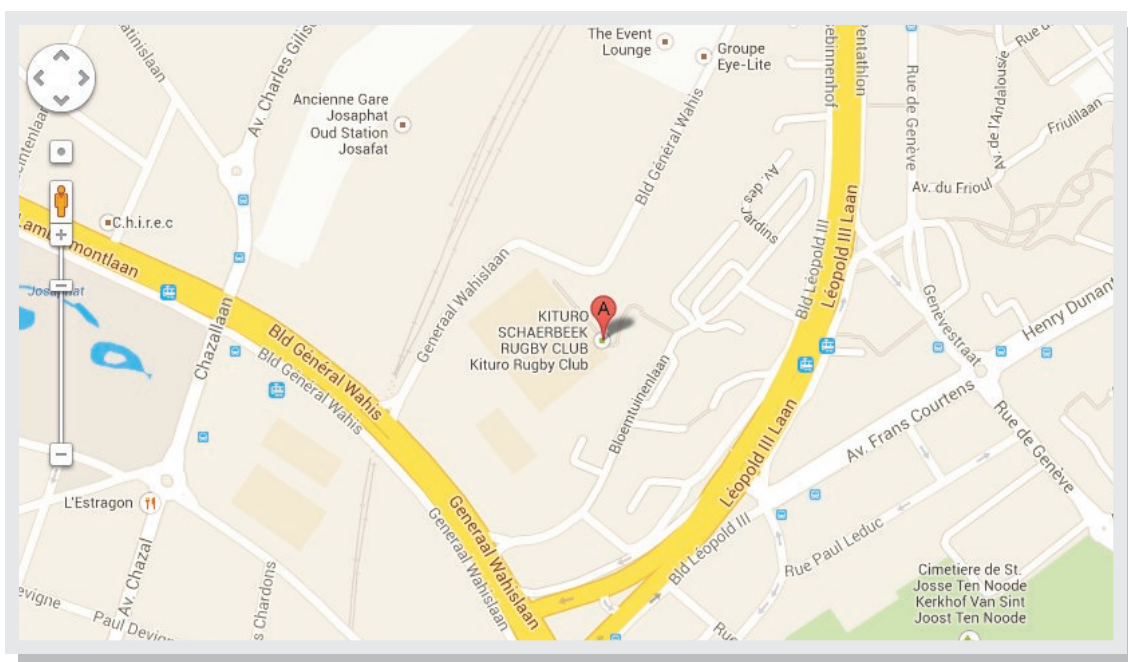

Getting to Brussels



By Plane:

There are two international airports serving the Brussels Region:

Brussels Airport (Zaventem) is the main Brussels airport and provides easy access to the city centre via bus, train or taxi.

Brussels Charleroi is located about 45 minutes outside of the city. Many budget airlines use this airport (Ryanair, etc.). A coach bus service runs every 30 minutes that will bring you into Brussels Midi station. From Midi, you can access anywhere in the city.

By Train:

There are three main train stations in the Brussels city area— Central Station (Gare Centrale), Brussels Midi (Brussels Zuid) and Brussels North (Gare du Nord).

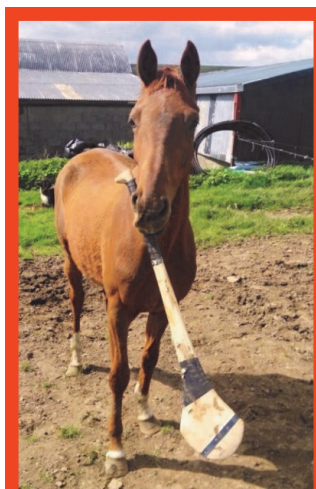
